	<b>Midgets</b> models 456 and 458. Also suit radios branded as <b>Peal</b> and <b>Malvern Star</b> in the midget series, as they were essentially Airzones	\$30

	<b>Mickey Mouse Bakelite</b> rare models EC along with the EG made 1937 to 1940 small square cover – will also suite the <b>Monarch</b> variations of the Mickey Mouse as Monarch were still available in this series during 1941.	\$30

	<b>Models 33, 35 and 38</b> - basically all fret and foot models, <b>Radiolettes</b> and <b>Hotpoint</b> variants	\$30
	<b>Egg Crate style Radiola and Radiolette</b> – born in late 1939 and still being produced in late 1946 - models 84, 86, 92, 310 and 509m. Also suits the console model Egg Crate Radiola and the 1941 and 1946 wooden <b>Bandmaster</b> versions of the Egg Crate Radiola.	\$30
